Standing Committee Reports

Bro. Kevin Riley gave a report that we have raised the funds for the speaker system in the dining room. Bro. Riley will give status report at the next stated meeting with details for installation.

Hon. James Salisbury then gave the Sickness & Distress report (copy attached).

Hon. Kickliter called on Bro. Salisbury for a **Membership report**. We have many new master masons in the area. Help us guide them to an outstanding Masonic experience. Remember we are the University of Freemasonry. If you want to know more about Masonry – this is the place.

Hon. Kickliter called on Bro. Joel Fairbanks to give the **VMAP report**. The VMAP program is going well. We would like to have our report ready by October. We have some minor details to complete but we would like this in the hands of the SGIG at his visit.

Hon. Kickliter asked for input on what the membership wanted to see out of their Valley. Ideas included:

- Camera and Televisions in the Dining Room so that everyone could see the speaker and/or PowerPoints or video presentations. This would be a great opportunity if we wanted to have a Valley function for Super Bowl.
- Improve the theatrical quality of the Lodge Room by adding LED lighting for the degrees. Ill. Larson also recommended that we think not only "wash lights" but LED spots to create the illusion of night Lodges, burning desert sands, etc.
- Sponsoring or helping out at a 5K run.
- Putting together a commercially produced PSA or commercial.
- Have a "tri-Valley" or regional reunion. Put on all 29 degrees.
- Sponsor the Orient of Louisiana's first three degree teams for a presentation in our area.
- Having a booth at the Pensacola Interstate Fair.
- Continuing Bellringers for the Salvation Army.
- Showing up to support the "Sea No Limits" Fishing Rodeo for kids with disabilities.
- Working the Polls during elections.

Hon. Kickliter then called for Old or Unfinished Business.

• Gene Bodkin reported he is still collecting cans for the Almoners Fund.

Hon. Kickliter then called for New Business.

- At the Council of 400 meeting in July the Valley learned:
 - That the Valley of Lake Worth is dealing with mold and a roof that needs replacement. The expected costs is over \$100,000. The Valley of Pensacola has contributed to this replacement.
 - The Valley of Orlando has sold its building for asking price and will be moving to Winter Park Lodge in September.
 - The question was asked who will be replacing Ill. Goehrig at the end of his term in 2018. He said that you need to ask the Sovereign Grand Commander and all the rest is rumor.
- At the Biennial Session of the Supreme Council:
 - Ill. Ronald A. Seale will not be seeking re-election in 2019. This will be his last term.
 - Two retirements were announced effective December 31, 2017. They are the SGIG in Minnesota and the SGIG in Florida.
 - Several rule changes are in the works including those regarding suspensions, re-instatements, and affiliations.
- Ill. Jimmy Lindt informed those present if they hadn't been to the Education and Sandwich Supper they are missing an outstanding program. James Gazaway, Bobby Kickliter and before them Kurt Larson have done an outstanding job of presenting the inner workings of the craft. These meetings are held on the first Wednesday of the month at 5:30 PM.

- Hon. Cris Villanueva indicated he would like to reinstitute the Chili Fundraiser. All present indicated they would support such an effort.
- Hon. Lloyd Magruder said that he would do the Red Beans and Rice if he had some help. This too people said they would participate in.
- The question was asked if we should have the Red and Black Auction. If was decided that this was a good event and should be held every three to five years.

Hon. Kickliter called upon the Personal Representative for any comments. The Personal Representative told us we had plenty of room and lots of chairs in the Lodge Room. Come join us for an excellent reunion.

Hon. Kickliter called upon Bro. Jerry Sumlin, Venerable Master of the Pensacola Lodge of Perfection, Bro. Alan Cox, Wise Master, Pensacola Chapter of Rose Croix, and Hon.
